

One Club Policy

The purpose of this policy is to clarify any confusion surrounding membership eligibility at our club, specifically addressing whether members can concurrently belong to other surfboard clubs.

Bondi Boardriders, aspires to be a premier club not only in the Sydney region but also nationally. This success is measured by the Club's overall performance, both within the competitive surfing arena and beyond. The Club's competitive spirit is evident in its participation in national events, where team selection offers surfers the opportunity to represent the club at local, state, and national levels.

Members are expected to support the club by contributing positively to the local community and respecting the beach, ocean, and community. The club values these contributions as highly as it values competition. Additionally, members should recognize and preserve the Bondi National Surfing Reserve.

The Bondi Boardriders Club hosts a maximum of 9 club contests annually, determining a club champion in each division.

The Club will provide surf/life coaching and development opportunities to foster young talent.

Members of the Bondi Boardriders are not permitted to join any other club without obtaining committee approval. This is because divided loyalty can undermine the spirit of the club and its goal of achieving the best possible results in competitions at all levels (Intra-Club, Local Area, Regional, State, National, International).

Therefore, when applying to join Bondi Boardriders;

- The individual should not be a member of an alternate boardriders Club. If this
 is the case then the individual is to advise the committee at the time of
 membership application via email to bondiboardriders@gmail.com;
- Once membership has been accepted by the committee the individual must represent and surf for Bondi (when selected) at representative surfing events and no other Surfboard Club:
- Following acceptance of membership and in the unlikely event that a member wishes to join, compete, and represent a second club, they must obtain approval from the committee by submitting a written application. The committee's decision on this matter is final;
- Members who surf for a competing club without committee knowledge and/or authorisation will be suspended from Bondi Boardriders for the remainder of the calendar year and will not be eligible for age champion titles. Continued unauthorised violations of this rule will result in expulsion from the Club for a period of 3 years.
